



## PARENTS PLEDGE OF COOPERATION

1. I will read the entire LCA Student Handbook and agree to abide by the Statement of Faith, Tuition Policy, Dress Code and all guidelines and rules as set forth.
2. As a Liberty Christian Academy parent, I recognize it is my privilege and responsibility to be supportive of the school's philosophy and Christian family commitments. As God enables me I will help Liberty Christian Academy in its effort to develop students spiritually, academically, physically and socially. If at any time I should become dissatisfied with the school in any respect, I will follow the Matthew 18 principle by first seeking to resolve the matter with the person or persons involved rather than spread criticism or hold a negative attitude in my heart.
3. Because of limited enrollment and stringent economy, it is hereby understood that the parent or guardian will keep all financial obligations up to date. Report cards may be held if obligations fall behind during any grading period. Payments not received by the last day of the month due may result in suspension.
4. The teacher(s) and administration are hereby given full discretion in the discipline of our child(ren). This would include the issuing of detention, suspension, and expulsion from school.
5. The teacher has full discretion, along with the administration, for the grade placement of my child(ren).
6. The school administration will be the final authority on all matters. Criticism, griping, and uncooperative attitudes on the part of students and parents alike in reference to these regulations and their enforcement will not be tolerated. If an attitude of Christian humility and cooperation is not possible by either student or parent, then the student may be dismissed from the school.
7. LCA is considered God's property. Respect for the appearance and care of our school property is a part of our Christian testimony. Property destroyed or damaged by any students will be repaired or replaced by the child's parents.
8. I give permission for my child to be photographed and videotaped at Liberty Christian Academy and during school functions and field trips. I understand that photographs and videos may be taken by school staff, faculty, or by other parents/guardians.
