I recently read an article entitled, *“The 17,000 Hour Decision: Why Christian Education Matters”*. The article included some sobering statistics regarding how our children are being influenced based on how they spend their time. In the average family, a student between the ages of 6 and 18, spends about 11,000 hours directly interacting with parents, 1,700 hours attending church, and 20,000 hours interacting with media. Students from preschool through 12th grade spend 17,000 hours in school. You decide who influences them during this time. Education matters!
